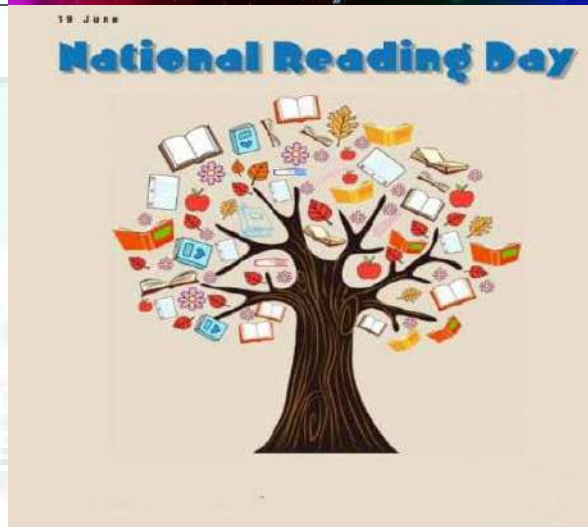

SCIENCE

ROLL NO.1 TO 5

- Make a 3D working model of pinhole camera. (Using cardboard paper etc)
- (Gather information from the internet and find out how the body temperature of animals such as cat ,dog ,horse camel ,cow and buffalo is measured. If there is any veterinary hospital in your vicinity you may visit to see the body temperature of animals being measured. Find out which places in India are usually regarded to be the coldest and hottest also find out the minimum and the maximum temperature is recorded for these places.

*Hang a room thermometer in your room , set up it on the wall and note down the readings of thermometers two to three times during the day and collect the readings for 10 days.

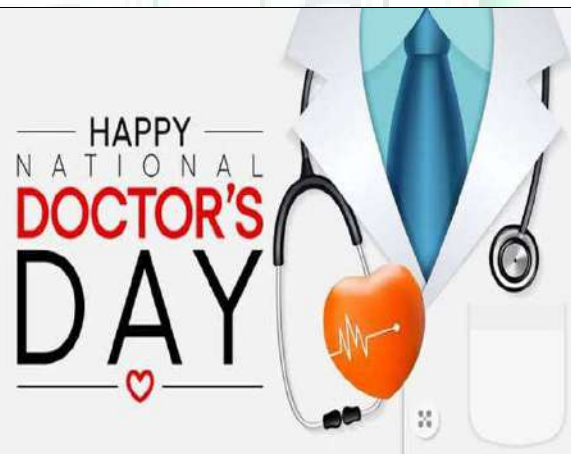
