What are the central themes of the book? (e.g., dreams, justice, courage, self-discovery)

5. Important Events / Turning Points:

What is one major event or turning point that changed the course of the story?

6. Personal Reflection:

What did you learn from the book?

Did you enjoy it? Why or why not?

7. Recommendation:

Would you recommend this book to your friends? Why?






